

**Escalation of Local Disaster Declaration
Village of TimberCreek Canyon, Texas**

LEVEL RED

Amarillo Mayor Ginger Nelson has issued a proclamation to be approved by Amarillo City Council latter this evening to move the COVID-19 threat level to Level Red at midnight, March 31, 2020. As Mayor of the Village of TimberCreek Canyon and with the approval of the Board of Aldermen, our community will follow Mayor Nelson's recommendation and upgrade our Local Disaster Declaration to **Level Red**.

Elements of **Level Red** include but are not limited to:

- Practice social distancing (6 ft. or greater with individuals outside immediate family)
- Enhance hygiene practice recommended (wash hands, alcohol hand sanitizer)
- Cancel all mass gatherings (10 individuals maximum for any group)
- If you are experiencing symptoms, call physician or Amarillo Health Department 378-6300
- Travel restrictions apply, limit all unnecessary travel (see www.AmarilloAlerts.com for additional information on essential vs. nonessential travel)
- Modification of public facilities (see www.AmarilloAlerts.com for additional information on essential vs. nonessential services or businesses)
- Follow www.coronavirus.gov or www.AmarilloAlerts.com for fact based information

The recommendation to move to **Level Red** has also been approved Amarillo Department of Public Health and John Milton, M.D., Infectious Disease Specialist.

The treat of COVID-19 has risen to such an extreme public health hazard that everyone needs to be aware and everyone needs to be "All IN" with public health recommendations according to Mayor Nelson. Social distancing is paramount along with appropriate handwashing. There are currently 11 people in Potter/Randall counties and these numbers will rise exponentially in the coming weeks. Three of the eleven patients brought the virus in from outside the counties. The remaining 8 have contracted the virus by "patient to patient" contact. There is currently no approve therapy or vaccine for this virus. The only way we will stop this disease is to break the person to person contact chain.

The main symptoms of COVID-19 are:

- Cough (dry)
- Fever
- Tiredness
- Difficulty breathing (severe cases, requires immediate medical attention)

If you experience these symptoms, contact your physician or call the Amarillo Health Department, 378-6300. If a person with symptoms becomes unconscious and has labored breathing, call **911**. If you are experiencing any of these symptoms, you should self-quarantine and seek medical attention. COVID-19 is spreading because individuals either have the virus without symptoms or they attributing their symptoms to hay fever, a cold or the flu. It is better to isolate or quarantine than to give the virus to others. Break the chain!

To those in our community who have tested “positive” for COVID-19 and are quarantined at home, please inform me or a Board member of your status. There are those in the community who have volunteered to help you and your family with groceries, medications, and other necessities. These individuals need to be aware of your status in order to protect themselves while delivering your supplies.

As Ginger Nelson has stated we need to be “ALL IN” in our attempt to reduce the spread of this virus. As a way of showing solidarity, she is recommending that we place something yellow by our door or in your yard to remind everyone who comes near that we should all do our part to stop the spread of this disease. I have even asked my wife, Susan to make a yellow flag that I will place under the U.S. flag on our flag pole for everyone to see and remember to take precautions.
