## Water Over the Dam (x 3)



The Village continues to receive rain and with water already in the creek, it takes less water to fill the creek and flow over the road and spill way. Friday afternoon water began rising and running over the road for the third time this spring/summer. By 4:00 p.m. water was about 9" over the road and by 8:00 p.m. the water was running 14 to 15" which required closure of the road until Saturday at noon. As a reminder, the Village will close the road anytime the water level rises above 12" on the dam. Although many residents have pickups or vehicles with a high wheel bases, you need to be careful crossing the dam in high water. If you decide to circumvent the road closure signs and cross the dam, you do so at your own risk. If you have a small car or one with a short wheel base exercise extreme caution when attempting to cross high water. Always approach running water with caution and check the water level gauge to determine the depth of the water. If you lose traction and the water pushes your car against the rails on the dam, do **NOT** exit your car and attempt to wade through the flowing water. Use your cell phone and call for help. The roads are closed during high water for safety of our residents and visitors. Please exercise caution and be safe!
