

MAYOR'S MESSAGE – April 2021

New Signs in the Village



Effective April 1, 2021, the creek is now closed to unauthorized motorized vehicles. Individuals have been using the creek bed for recreational purposes and have on several occasions become stuck in mud. In attempts to free their vehicles from the mud, the loud exhausts and commotions from vehicles trying to pull the stuck vehicle out are posing concerns to area residents and is disturbing the peace. The creek bed is owned by residents whose property extends into the creek and by the Village. Residents whose property extends into the creek and Village authorized individuals may continue to access their property by driving in the creek bed. All other individuals are trespassing since this area is now posted. If there is enough water in the creek to allow residents to canoe or use a small rowboat, they may do so and this will not constitute a “trespass violation”. Hiking is allowed in the creek bed but please remember that walking outside of the creek banks places you on someone’s property. Please be aware that there are Noise Ordinances (Ordinances 3.02, 5.07) and excessive noise after 10:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m. is prohibited. Complaints should be registered with the Village Chief of Police. The new Chief of Police will be announced at the April 8th Board of Aldermen meeting and his contact number posted on the Village web site at www.timbercreekcanyon.org.

Village Cleanup – April 24, 2021

Village cleanup is scheduled for Saturday, April 24th. and we will meet at the Fire station at 9:00 and make assignments. The focus this year will be to pickup roadside trash and dispose of brush and tree trimmings.

There have been several changes this year that will effect how we will conduct the Village cleanup. The roll-off will be located at 102 Hackberry (please see map). Do not bring any brush or tree trimmings to the Tennis Court or Fire station! There will only be one roll-off and it will be available on Friday, April 16th. The A&M Texas Forestry service will be here Saturday April 24th to chip brush and tree limbs. Do **NOT** bring yucca, lumber or building materials to the site since residents will be responsible for disposal of these items. The chip site at Hackberry will be closed Sunday, April 25th and we will not accept any trimmings before the 16th or after the 24th.

You should enter 102 Hackberry through the gate and then turn left (south). If you pull your trailer south, you may then back up to the old house foundation to unload your material. You may place limbs and brush on the foundation and into the front yard. Please do not block area next to fence and leave room for people to back up and then drive up the hill and out the south side of the property. Exit will be marked with flags and cones (see map). The front gate will be locked until April 16th and then after April 25th. Limbs and brush will only be accepted between the above dates.

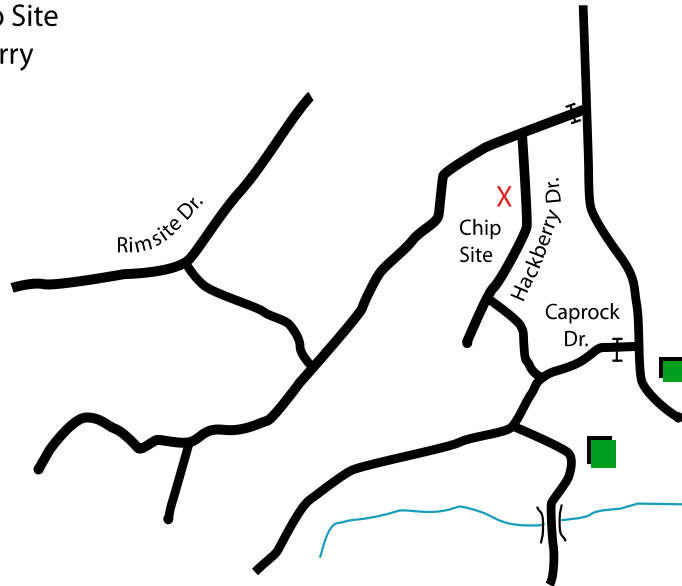

1. Enter chip site from Hackberry through gate
2. Turn left, boundaries are marked
3. Unload West of path
4. Continue up hill and exit back on Hackberry (south of entry)
5. Dates open: 4/16 to 4/24
