BE SURE AND MARK YOUR CALENDARS FOR OCTOBER 18TH FOR THE TIMBERCREEK FALL CLEANUP AND FIREWISE AWARENESS EVENT (TO BE HELD AT PALISADES). MEET AT THE TIMBERCREEK FIRE STATION AT 9AM AND PICK UP AN ASSIGNMENT TO WORK ON A SMALL PROJECT HERE IN OUR NEIGHBORHOOD. BRING CHAINSAWS, LOPPERS, RAKES, ETC. THEN COME OVER FOR A FREE BURGER OR HOT DOG AT PALISADES COMMUNITY CENTER FROM 11-1.

OUR CHIP SITE IS OPEN FOR YOUR BRUSH OR TREE LIMBS. PLACE THOSE ON THE PILE NEXT TO THE ROLL OFF. DO NOT BLOCK THE MAIN AREAS. PLACE YUCCA OR CACTUS IN THE ROLL OFF. PLEASE NO HOUSEHOLD TRASH, CONSTRUCTION WASTE OR OTHER DEBRIS! HELP MAKE YOUR PROPERTY AND TIMBERCREEK A LITTLE MORE FIREWISE!

CONSTRUCTION IS NEARLY COMPLETE ON THE COMMUNITY CENTER BUILDING. WE HAVE BEEN ABLE TO SECURE ADDITIONAL GRANT FUNDING FOR SOME ADDITIONAL BUILDING AND SITE AMMENITIES. WORK IS PROGRESSING ON THE PARKING LOT AND EXTERIOR SITE IMPROVEMENTS.





WE ARE HOLDING A PUBLIC HEARING ON OCTOBER 1 AT 6PM AT THE FIRE STATION CONCERNING THE PROPOSED COMMUNICATIONS TOWER AT THE COMMUNITY CENTER SITE ON HACKBERRY. ALSO TIMBERCREEK POLICE AND FIRE WILL BE ON HAND TO EXPLAIN THE BENEFITS OF THE RANDALL COUNTY TOWER. RESIDENTS WILL BE LIMITED TO 5 MINUTES EACH FOR SPEAKING/QUESTIONS. THIS WILL ALOW EVERYONE WHO WISHES TO SPEAK AN OPPORTUNITY TO DO SO.

ANNOUNCEMENT FROM THE POA BOARD:

After close to five years the Osage Gate House Culvert Project has come to fruition. We are under contract with Precision Excavation and the Notice to Proceed has been issued. The project schedule is to begin on October 15, 2025, and to be completed on or before November 30, 2025, weather permitting. The project plans prepared by J. Shehan Engineering consists of a new 54" corrugated metal pipe inserted inside the existing pipe. There will be flow fill between the new and existing pipes for stability. Concrete headwalls will be placed at both ends of the pipe. Metal guard rails will be placed along the edge of the road pavement for safety. Working hours will be from 8:00am to 5:00pm weekdays. It is anticipated that the roadway and gate will remain open but may be closed from time to time for safety purposes. Should road and gate closure become necessary, you will be detoured to the Wild Plum gate for in and out access.

Please be patient with this construction process and our contractor.
